

I hereby consent for my child to participate in the Transportation methods used at BGC Wetaskiwin. I understand that it is my responsibility to make arrangements for transportation between the child's residence and program facilities.

Bussing

1. The BGC Wetaskiwin bus will be used to transport registered participants to and from the following schools:

• Centennial (5310 – 55 Avenue)	Before School
• Clear Vista (4510 – 47 Street)	Before School
• Norwood School (5505 - 44 Street)	Before and/or Afterschool
• Parkdale School (4107 – 54 Street)	Before and/or Afterschool
• Queen Elizabeth (4720 – 51 Street)	Before School
• Sacred Heart School (4419 – 52 Avenue)	Before and/or Afterschool
2. The bus will drop off/pick up registered participants at the designated times and school/OSC locations.
3. Participants are expected to be prepared for the weather conditions.
4. Bussing will not operate if any of the following occurs:
 - a. Temperature of -40 degrees Celsius with or without a wind chill factor as reported by the weather office for the area in question;
 - b. Visibility of less than 30 meters;
 - c. Road closures by the R.C.M.P, municipality, or other local road officials.
5. Once seated, participants will wear seatbelts until they arrive at their designated location.

Walking Bus

1. The walking bus will transport registered participants on designated program days from the following schools:
 - Centennial (5310 – 55 Avenue)
 - Clear Vista (4510 – 47 Street)
 - Queen Elizabeth (4720 – 51 Street)
2. Out of School Care staff will meet registered participants at designated locations and times at each school to walk to their Out of School Care program.
3. Participants are expected to be prepared for the weather conditions.
4. The walking bus will not operate if there is inclement weather (ie: lightning or pouring rain) or if the temperature is -25 degrees Celsius, or colder, with or without wind chill at of the time of departure. In these situations, the BGC Wetaskiwin Bus will be used to transport registered children from the schools to the program.

Behaviour Expectations

1. It is the registered participant's responsibility to ensure that they meet at the designated locations on time for the bus or walking bus. If they are late, it is their responsibility (or parent/guardian) to make alternative arrangements.
2. The participant must follow the direction and guidelines of the bus driver and/or staff.
3. In consultation with the bus drivers and staff, the Director reserves the right to suspend transportation privileges to anyone not following the directions and/or guidelines. Length

of suspensions will be based on the severity of the incident.

Off-Site Activities

The Out of School Care programs will access parks throughout the year using one of the aforementioned methods of transportation (the BGC Bus or Walking Bus). The following are parks which may be accessed for each OSC program location.
